We have really enjoyed our Yoga sessions!

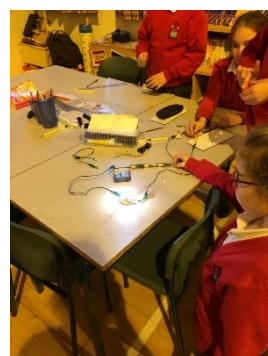
